At age 17, she was impressed that God had a place for her talent but never quite understood what it was to be. Now, with grown children, a satisfying 34 year marriage, supportive husband and an abiding relationship with Jesus, God has commissioned Julie with her mission.

"Take timeless Christ centered lyrics from the past and make them new with progressive music which reaches deep into the heart and soul."

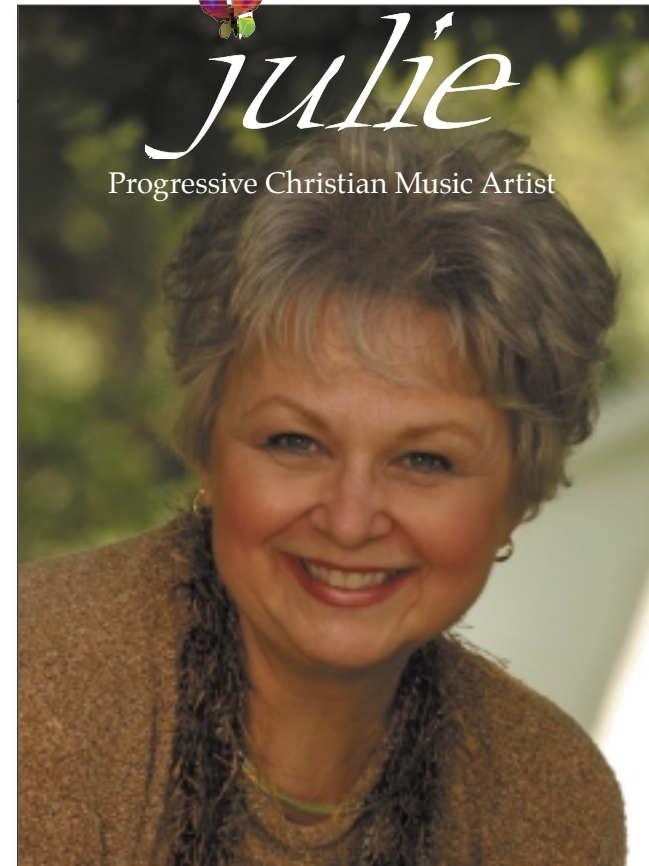
